Canyon Heights Booster Station Upgrade Project

What's happening?

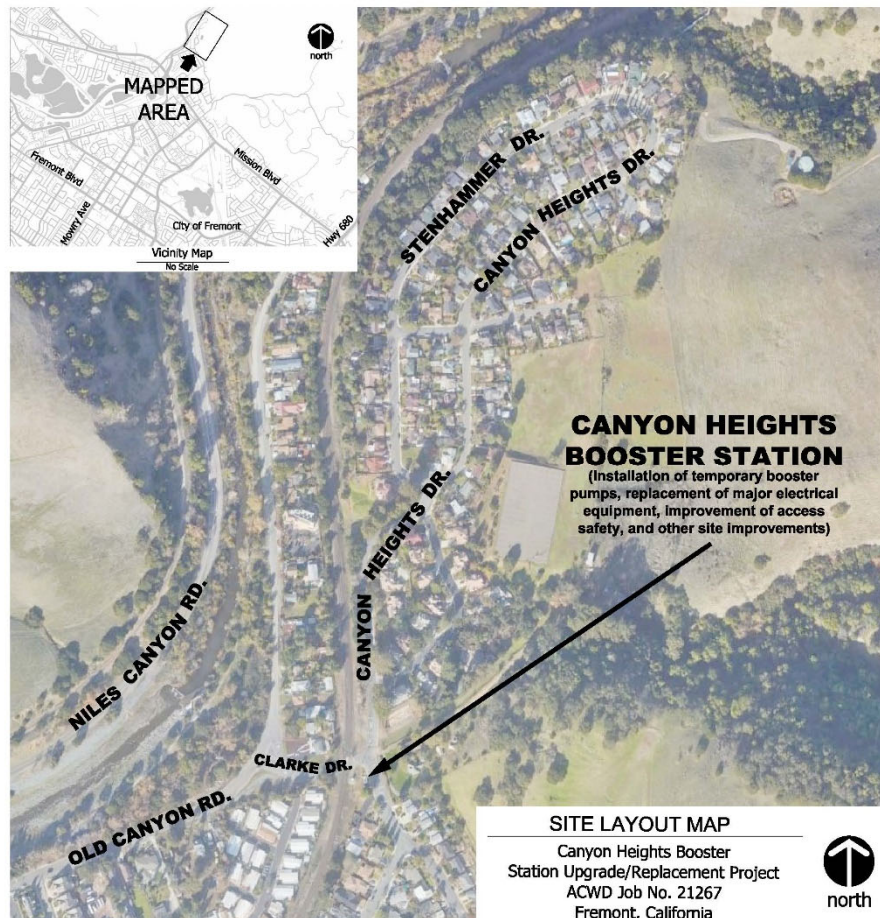
The Alameda County Water District (ACWD) continues to invest in infrastructure to help ensure a reliable supply of high quality drinking water to our customers. To improve water quality, supply, and storage reliability in your neighborhood, ACWD will soon begin an upgrade project on the Canyon Heights Booster Station. The Canyon Heights Booster Station is located at the corner of Canyon Heights Drive and Clarke Drive in Fremont (see map below). The Project will involve the replacement of essential electrical equipment, site safety improvements, and other miscellaneous site improvements. Temporary equipment will be installed at the Canyon Heights Booster Station during construction and will help continue delivery of reliable, high-quality water to area customers during construction.

When will construction begin?

Construction is scheduled to start in December 2020 and will be performed by the Alameda County Water District's contractor for this project, Valentine Corporation.

How long will the construction take?

The project, in its entirety, is expected to be completed in 7 months (December 2020 – July 2021).



How will I be impacted?

The project, including the temporary provisions for construction, the replacement of the essential electrical equipment, site safety improvements, and other miscellaneous site improvements will occur on ACWD's property near the public right-of-way. However, the project is expected to have minimal impact on residents and businesses.

No interruptions to your water service are planned nor expected. If a planned interruption is required, notification will be provided at least 24 hours in advance to those customers who will be impacted.

What can I expect during construction?

- **Visual**

Minimal construction traffic, including construction vehicles and equipment, are expected throughout the course of the project. In addition, the contractor will have small stockpiles of materials, including but not limited to, pipe, and soil/aggregates.

- **Construction Noise**

When construction is occurring, residents may hear construction noise and/or experience vibrations.

- **Traffic Control Measures**

At certain times during the project, temporary traffic control measures may be implemented along Canyon Heights Drive.

- **Workspace Safety**

Construction activities will be completed in accordance with all federal, state and local safety regulations and guidelines. Nevertheless, construction sites can be dangerous. The site will be barricaded and secured for the safety of the crew and the public. Please maintain a safe distance from all construction equipment and materials.

- **Working Hours**

Work hours are anticipated to be Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. No work is planned on Saturdays, Sundays or ACWD holidays.
