**ONE SAVES WATER**



## SAVE WATER INDOORS:

- Install high-efficiency spray valves in kitchens
- Install aerators on handwashing sinks
- Wash full loads of dishes and laundry
- Educate employees and building occupants on the importance of water use efficiency
- Replace an inefficient toilet or urinal - [Rebates Available!](#)

## SAVE WATER OUTDOORS:

- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean sidewalks, parking lots, and other hardscapes
- Remove lawn and install water-efficient plants – [Rebates Available!](#)
- Check irrigation systems for leaks and repair broken sprinkler heads and broken irrigation pipes
- Check position of sprinkler heads to ensure water is not directed towards non-landscape areas
- Water during the coolest parts of the day (early morning and late evening) and avoid watering on windy days

## TIPS FOR HOTELS:

- Use pool covers or liquid barriers to control evaporation loss
- Monitor water levels in pools – if a pool loses 2 inches or more per week, a leak is likely present
- Allow guests to opt out of daily linen and towel washing

## TIPS FOR RESTAURANTS:

- Only serve water on request
- Thaw frozen food in a refrigerator instead of using running water
- Install automatic shutoffs so water doesn't run when garbage disposal or faucets are not in use
