

### What's happening?


The Alameda County Water District (ACWD) continues to invest in infrastructure to help ensure a reliable supply of high-quality drinking water to our customers. To improve water quality, emergency and fire flow and storage and seismic reliability in your neighborhood, ACWD will soon begin an upgrade project at the Alameda Reservoir, a covered potable water storage facility built in 1972. The Alameda Reservoir is located between Klamath Street and Paseo Padre Parkway in Fremont (see map below). The project will involve the replacement and seismic strengthening of the roof structure, the addition of ventilation fans and interior lighting, and miscellaneous site and safety improvements.

### When will construction begin?

Construction is scheduled to start in May 2023 and will be performed by the Alameda County Water District's contractor for this project, Thompson Builders.

### How long will the construction take?

The project, in its entirety, is expected to be completed in 14 months (May 2023 – July 2024).



## How will I be impacted?

The project will occur on ACWD's property accessed through Shoshone Court.

No interruptions to your water service are planned or expected. If a planned interruption is required, notification will be provided at least 24 hours in advance to those customers who will be impacted.

## What can I expect during construction?

- **Visual**

Moderate construction traffic, including construction vehicles and equipment, is expected throughout the course of the project.

- **Construction Noise**

When construction is occurring, residents may hear construction noise and/or experience vibrations. Construction noise will reduce in intensity following demolition work scheduled for summer 2023. Acoustic fencing barriers will be installed to mitigate construction noise.

- **Traffic Control Measures**

At certain times during the project, temporary traffic control measures may be implemented along Klamath Street and Shoshone Court.

- **Workspace Safety**

Construction activities will be completed in accordance with all federal, state and local safety regulations and guidelines. Nevertheless, construction sites can be dangerous. The site will be barricaded and secured for the safety of the crew and the public. Please maintain a safe distance from all construction equipment and materials.

- **Working Hours**

Work hours are anticipated to be Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. No work is planned on Saturdays, Sundays or ACWD holidays.
