Groundwater PFAS Treatment Facility Project

What’s happening?

The Alameda County Water District (ACWD) continues to invest in infrastructure to ensure a reliable supply of drinking water that meets all regulatory requirements to our customers. In order to provide reliable, high-quality water for our Customers, ACWD will commence treating local groundwater to remove PFAS compounds by constructing the Groundwater PFAS Treatment Facility (Project). PFAS are man-made (synthetic) compounds used in many consumer and industrial products for their ability to repel stains, water, and oil. PFAS are persistent in the environment and do not readily degrade.


The Project is located on the District’s existing Peralta-Tyson Blending Facility property at 1111 Mowry Avenue in Fremont (see Site Location on map below). The Project will involve installing new pumps, cartridge filters, and pressure vessels on a concrete pad as well as associated yard piping, civil improvements, and electrical upgrades.

When will construction begin?

Construction will begin in December 2023.

How long will the construction take?

The project is anticipated to be completed in approximately 16 months (December 2023 – April 2025).



How will I be impacted?

The project's site improvements will occur on ACWD's property and are expected to have minimal impact on residents during construction. No interruptions to your water service are expected for this project.

What can I expect during construction?

- **Visual**

Some additional traffic is anticipated during construction, including delivery vehicles and construction equipment, are expected throughout the course of the project to and from the site.

- **Working Hours**

Work hours are anticipated to be Monday through Friday, between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. No work is planned on Saturdays, Sundays or ACWD holidays. Should weekend work be required to accommodate continuity of water service, ACWD will work to minimize impacts to surrounding residents.

- **Workspace Safety**

Construction activities will be completed in accordance with all federal, state, and local safety regulations and guidelines. Nevertheless, construction sites can be dangerous. All construction activities will occur behind the gate at the Blending Facility. The gate will remain locked and closed for the safety of the crew and the public. Please do not enter the site for any reason.

- **Construction Noise**

When construction is occurring, residents may hear construction noise and/or experience construction related vibrations.
