#### LOCATION

The Project is located within the public right of way on H Street between Alvarado-Niles Road and Colgate Drive, on 13<sup>th</sup> Street between H and I Streets, on 4<sup>th</sup> Street between F and G Streets, and on G Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets in Union City.

#### PROJECT BENEFITS

The Project will replace aging infrastructure, improve system hydraulics, and reduce the number of future breaks and leaks that could result in unplanned water service outages and water quality issues. This Project represents a critical investment for ACWD in support of our commitment to providing customers with reliable water service.

#### PROJECT SCOPE

The Project will involve installing of approximately 3,720 feet of 8-inch pipeline, associated fittings, valves, water service laterals, fire hydrants and other appurtenances. Pipeline construction involves digging an open trench, laying the pipeline and service line inside the trench, connecting the pipe segments together, backfilling the trench, and restoring the pavement to its original condition.

#### TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

The pipeline construction will require lane closures and intersection interruptions along the proposed pipeline alignment. Additionally, planned water service interruptions are also expected. The District and the contractor will work to minimize impact where possible, however, some impacts are unavoidable during construction. Construction work will cause temporary delays, traffic, lane closures, detours, construction-related noise, dust, and limited parking in the vicinity of the work. "No parking" signs will be posted along the project route where necessary and flaggers will be present to ensure traffic flow

during construction. Notice will be provided to residents and businesses before the construction begins. Water service interruptions that range in the duration of two to eight hours will occur when connecting new pipeline to the existing water main system. Notice will be provided to affected customers 24 hours before the outages.

**ESTIMATED TIMELINE**

Construction will commence in March 2025 and will be performed by JMB Construction Inc., ACWD’s appointed contractor. The project is anticipated to be completed in approximately four months (March 2025 – June 2025) within Union City.

Working hours are anticipated to be Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Special hours or night work may apply when working at certain locations or to perform certain construction work. Refer to the chart below for special work hours near James Logan High School. The contractor will strive to maintain the working hours indicated and reduce the inconvenience associated with very early and very late construction. However, longer construction hours may occasionally be required to minimize water service disruptions and/or to reduce traffic impacts.
